Public Comment

Lt. Charles Gonglik of the Pennsylvania State Police addressed the Board. Lt. Gonglik is the municipal liaison for Perry Township. During the first five months of 2019, the State Police responded to 206 calls for service in the Township, including accidents and speeding on Route 51, thefts, noise complaints, and domestic disputes.

Whitsett resident Dewayne Johnson thanked Lt. Gonglik for the regular patrols on Township Road 495 (River Road).

Wickhaven resident Art Shipley requested a “No Outlet” sign at the intersection of Wickhaven Road and Hilltop Road.

Mr. Myers, who lives on Holly Road, said that he uses Maplewood and Court Roads, and that gravel may not be needed for winter traction in those areas. The gravel builds up and goes into the yards. However, he said that the snow removal service is excellent. Chairman Boni explained that the Township uses a mix of gravel, cinders and salt. Mr. Myers also asked that the shoulders and banks be cut back.
